NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON  
PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE  
ZONING ORDINANCE**

**January 9, 2018**

The Rose Township Planning Commission will hold a public hearing in the Township Meeting Hall at Township Offices, 9080 Mason Street, Holly, Thursday, February 1, 2018. The Planning Commission meeting starts at 7:00 PM. The estimated time of the "Winery, Small" public hearing is 7:30 PM.

The public hearing is for the purpose of considering amendments to the Zoning Ordinance, in accordance with the Michigan Zoning Enabling Act (Public Act 12 of 2008). The following is a summary of the amendments proposed:

- Section 38.6 would be amended to create a definition for "Winery, Small."
- Section 38.179 would be amended to add Winery, Small, to the Schedule of Uses to permit Winery, Small, as a special land use and an accessory use in the AG/RP District with special use standards, 38.582.
- Section 38.582 would be amended to create specific special use standards for Winery, Small, including dimensional, screening, and various compliance regulations.

The Ordinance text is available for public inspection at the Township Offices, during regular business hours between 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM. Any resident or property owner may participate in the hearing, or submit written comments to the Township prior to Wednesday, January 31, 2018.
