Directions to Holly Area Veterans' Resource Center (HAVRC)

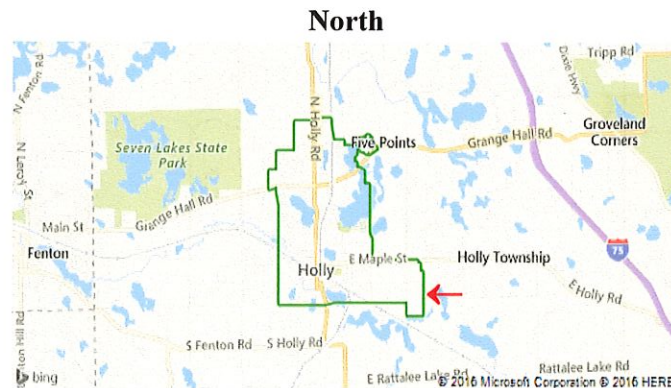
The HAVRC is located in the Karl Richter Community Center off East Holly Road; Room C-309. It is in the same building as the Village of Holly Offices. Enter the doors to the right of the building where the Village of Holly Offices are located. Turn right, then left.

HAVRC is the last room on the left before the double doors, **C-309**.

From the North: I-75 South to Exit 98, turn left from the exit ramp (west), go 3.5 miles and turn left into the Karl Richter Community Center.

From the South: I-75 North to Exit 98, turn left (west) onto East Holly Road, go 3.5 miles and turn left into the Karl Richter Community Center.

From the West: From Grange Hall Road turn right onto Saginaw St., turn left onto Maple St. and then turn right into the Karl Richter Community Center.



Certified Service Officers from Oakland County Veterans Affairs Office will be available the first Tuesday of each month. They will be at the Holly Area Veterans' Resource Center from 8:30 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.
