WATER & SEWER**Does Rose Township provide water and sewer services?**

All of Rose Township is serviced by well and septic. For information about wells and septic systems, contact Oakland County Health Health Division, 248-858-1280

PERMITS, ZONING & CONSTRUCTION**When do I need a building permit?**

A permit is required when constructing a new structure over 200 sq. ft., adding to or altering a structure, or changing the use of a space.

What work does not require a permit?

No permit is needed for fences, freestanding structures 200 sq. ft. or less, or routine maintenance.

Where do I obtain building permits?

All building, electrical, mechanical, and plumbing permits are available at 9080 Mason St., Holly, MI 48442.

TAX & ASSESSMENT QUESTIONS

How do I look up or pay my property taxes? The Treasurer's Office manages all tax payments and maintains searchable property tax records.

What exemptions are available? Veterans' exemptions, hardship exemptions, poverty exemptions, and mobile home tax administration options are available.
