

Fireworks and Flannels



This year's Fireworks and Flannels event at [Waterford Oaks County Park](#) will feature two days of activities that promise something for everyone. Presented by Oakland County Parks, the festivities begin on Friday, Feb. 13 with the Light the Night Flannel 5K and then the fun continues on Saturday, Feb. 14 with Cozy Night Out, an evening filled with activities that highlight the cozier side of winter.

Light the Night Flannel 5K

The race evening begins with the opening of the lighted trail at 5 p.m. Friday, Feb. 13. After the race, enjoy an inviting bonfire, hot cocoa and a quiet night under the stars.

The Light the Night Flannel 5K is out and back race that runs along a beautiful, wooded trail with both paved and natural terrain. View the [race map](#). Participants are welcome to run or walk while wearing their comfiest, coziest flannel. Leashed dogs are allowed.

Race cost is \$28/person. Each participant will receive a race beanie, medal and drink ticket for the Sat., Feb. 14 beer tent, part of the Fireworks and Flannels Cozy Night Out event. Take in the winter scenery by relaxing on a horse-drawn wagon ride around the park and enjoy meeting new animal friends at a petting farm with pony rides from 4-7 p.m. Relax with live music in the warmth of the beer tent, play winter games, create a craft, enjoy face painting, or stroll along the illuminated walking path from 4-8 p.m. The sledding hill will be open, weather permitting. Food trucks will serve welcoming comfort food with cozy fire pits nearby to sit and enjoy a meal.

The event will wrap up with a frosty fireworks display that will light up the wintry skies beginning at 8 p.m. Bring a camping chair and warm clothing to watch the fireworks outdoors or enjoy the view from the comfort of your heated vehicle.
