TO ALL COUNTY CLERKS:

You are hereby notified that a General Election will be held in all voting precincts of this state on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, at which time candidates of the Democratic Party, Republican Party, Libertarian Party, U.S. Taxpayers Party, Green Party, Natural Law Party, and Working Class Party and candidates without political party affiliation who seek election to the following partisan offices are to be voted for in your county: President of the United States and Vice President of the United States, United States Senator, Representative in Congress, Representative in State Legislature, Member of the State Board of Education, Regent of the University of Michigan, Trustee of Michigan State University, Governor of Wayne State University, and such other partisan offices that may by law be required to be filled at this election. Candidates seeking election to the following nonpartisan offices are also to be voted for in your county at the November 5, 2024 General Election: Justice of Supreme Court, Judge of Court of Appeals, Judge of Circuit Court (in counties with positions to fill), Judge of Probate Court (in counties with positions to fill), Judge of Probate District Court (in counties with positions to fill), Judge of District Court (in counties with positions to fill), and such other nonpartisan offices that may by law be required to be filled at this election. As of this date there are no state-wide initiated laws or constitutional amendments on the ballot this year.

This notice is provided in compliance with Michigan election law, MCL 168.648.
