


## **FREE Weatherization Assistance Program**

## Weatherization Assistance Program Goal Statement

The goal of the Weatherization Assistance Program is for the weatherization team (weatherization coordinator, intake staff, pre/post inspectors and crew/contractors) and the client to work together as partners to save energy, to make the home more comfortable and reduce energy bills.



## What you need to know for your appointment:

Please bring the following items with you:

- Proof of income for last 3 months for all
  - household members
- 2018 award letter if you receive assistance such as social
  - security, disability, unemployment
    - Recent gas and electric bill
      - Photo ID
- If mobile home owner, home must be less than 15 years old,
  - copy of the title is required
  - Food assistance letter

You must meet income eligibility guidelines and be at or below 200% of poverty.

For households with more than 8 people add \$8,640.
