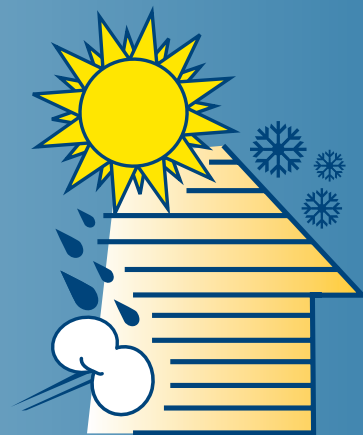

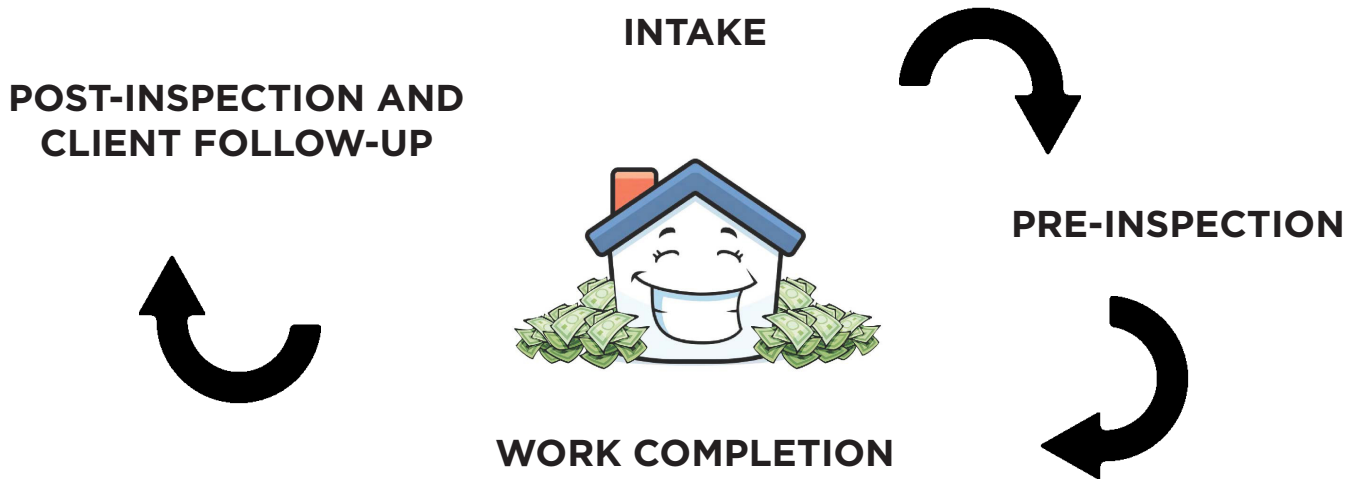


Weatherization Works

Weatherization Assistance Program Goal Statement

The goal of the Weatherization Assistance Program is for the weatherization team (weatherization coordinator, intake staff, pre/post inspectors and crew/contractors) and the client to work together as partners to save energy, to make the home more comfortable and reduce energy bills.

Weatherization Assistance Program Process



What you need to know for your appointment:

Please bring the following items with you:

- Proof of income for last 3 months for all household members
- 2018 award letter if you receive assistance such as social security, disability, unemployment
 - Recent gas and electric bill
 - Photo ID
- If mobile home owner, home must be less than 15 years old, copy of the title is required
 - Food assistance letter

You must meet income eligibility guidelines and be at or below 200% of poverty.
